Bapchild CC Club Representatives (and Volunteers)

1. As the Club Representative you are responsible for the safety and well being of all participants - please ensure you follow the guidelines where appropriate.
2. Please make sure that the Groundsmen and the Chairman are informed of all games to be held at home or away
3. When visiting the Pavilion on a non-match day please register your visit by texting the COVID Mobile

7. In the Event someone becomes symptomatic during the activity

- a) Maintain social distancing
- b) If the person is able to travel home safely they should travel home and manage their symptoms in accordance with NHS and PHE guidance
- c) If the person is too unwell to travel home safely, then open the window to ventilate the COVID-19 Isolation room. Isolate the person and contact someone from their household to make safe arrangements for travel. Keep the door closed. If you or others need to enter the isolation room then masks, visors, gloves and aprons are available - additional sanitiser is in the room.
- d) If the above is not possible then phone 111 and follow the instruction
- e) Once the person has left the ground ensure the isolation room is closed off from use and inform the Chairman at the earliest opportunity.

NOTE : When anyone is injured the first aiders should wear the appropriate PPE equipment
- Remember to complete the Accident Book and inform the Chairman

The room should be cleaned after use

8. In the event you are contacted that a participant has tested positive within 21 Days of the activity

Contact the Chairman at the earliest opportunity and await instructions
