Guidance for Spectators with regards to COVID-19

Spectators

1. NO Spectators are allowed at the ground during STEP 2 unless exempt to look after a disabled participant or supervising an under 18 player
2. Participating players under the age of 16 (or 18 if the parent so chooses) will need to be supervised by one adult from their Household/bubble for the duration of the activity (including before and after the game while at the ground). The Adult will be exempt as a spectator and allowed to stay.
3. Exempt Spectators should maintain social distancing at all times in line with current UK Government Guidance (Currently 2m / two households or 6 people from different households)
4. Exempt Spectators should sit no closer than 3m to the boundary
5. Hand sanitiser should be used regularly and particularly at the start/end of the activity and prior to consuming any food or drinks.
6. No spectator should approach the scorers and should always remain socially distanced (2m)
7. Exempt Spectators should remain socially distanced at all times and refrain from all contact with the ball e.g. returning it to the field of play.
8. Exempt Spectator groups must be restricted to two household/bubbles or six person gatherings and spread out, in line facing the field of play while maintaining social distancing.
9. Individuals should bring their own food and drink
10. In the event of rain, spectators should return to their own vehicle to maintain social distancing if there is insufficient outdoor cover from the rain
11. Exempt Spectators may view the cricket from their cars where there is sufficient parking - other participants should respect their distance
12. Exempt Spectators should refrain from shouting
13. Exempt Spectators should sanitise their hands after the completion of activity.
14. Social gathering after the activity will be allowed in line with current UK Government guidelines on hospitality and social distancing must be maintained.
15. Participants should exit whilst maintaining social distancing
16. The Club encourages all spectators to report any infection of their household to the NHS Test and Trace system following the activity to limit the spread of the virus (<https://www.gov.uk/guidance/nhs-test-and-trace-how-it-works>).

You should also inform the club at the earliest opportunity (for up to 21 days after the activity).
